A new presence for Toyota in the C segment crossover market, C-HR will bring efficiency, low emissions and technology with the latest generation 1.8-litre hybrid powertrain. Demonstrating the flexibility of Toyota New Global Architecture (TNGA), the C-HR remains remarkably true to the features of the concept cars that previously attracted so much public attention.
