1984		UK launch of the rear-wheel drive Corolla Coupe GT.
1985	February	Introduction of the Corolla 3-door and 1.3-litre 2E triple-valve petrol engine to the range. Introduction of the front-wheel drive Corolla GT.
1986	July	Introduction of the Corolla GL Executive
1987	September	The 6 th generation Corolla debuts in three and five-door, Liftback and estate body styles.
1989	April	The Corolla 4WD Estate is added to the range in the UK.
1992	August	The seventh generation Corolla is launched, with 1.3 and 1.6-litre petrol engines and Xli, Gli and Executive trim grades. Five body styles are offered: three and five-door, four-door saloon, five-door Liftback and estate.
1993	March	A new 2.0-litre diesel engine is added to the range, together with a new 1.8 GXi three-door model.
1994	September	Driver's airbag becomes standard feature on all Corolla models.
1995	August	The Corolla range adopts a new grade structure and improved equipment specifications.
1997		Eighth generation Corolla is launched. Late in the year production of hatchback versions begins at Toyota's Burnaston factory.
2000	February	Corolla undergoes extensive changes, including new front-end design and addition of new 1.4 and 1.6 VVT-i engines. Four grades are offered: S, GS, SR and GLS.
2000	July	Limited edition Corolla Vida is introduced.
2001	February	Corolla Calida joins the range as a special edition model.
2001	September	Ninth generation Corolla is revealed at the Frankfurt motor show.
2002	January	UK sales of the new Corolla are launched.
	February	Corolla is What Car magazine's car of the year.
	August	Corolla range is completed with introduction of the saloon model.
	November	Corolla T Sport 5-door model and T3 D-4D diesel are added to the line-up.
2003	May	Arrival of a new 114bhp 2.0 D-4D engine in the Corolla range.
2004	June	The Corolla range is revised and new 1.4 D-4D engine is introduced.
2005	January	The first Corolla Colour Collection models are announced.

2005	April	Furrther Corolla Colour Collection models join the range.
2005	November	The 215bhp supercharged Corolla Compressor is launched
2007	February	Corolla's place in the Toyota range is taken by the new Auris.
