

SUPRA TIMELINE

1978		The Supra name is introduced as a version of the second generation Celica, the Celica Supra.
1982	August	The Celica Supra is launched as part of the third generation Celica range.
1986	July	Supra becomes a stand-alone model and is introduced as a new flagship for Toyota in the UK.
1988	October	The production Supra Turbo makes its UK public debut at the British International Motor Show.
1989	January	The Supra Turbo is launched in the UK.
	March	Toyota announces it will defend its BTCC title with the Supra Turbo.
	October	The naturally aspirated Supra gains a three-way catalyst.
1991	March	Supra and Supra Turbo gain new-design wheels and an 8-speaker sound system with RDS radio.
1993	August	The fourth generation Supra is launched in the UK
1996		Final year of Supra sales in the UK.
2019	May	Supra returns with the launch of the all-new GR Supra.
